### Welcome to the Effectiveness Bank

**Drug and Alcohol Findings** bridges the divide between research on the effectiveness of responses to drug and alcohol problems and the practitioners who provide those interventions, with a focus on UK-relevant research.

**Findings** encapsulates the studies' findings, sets them in context and explores the implications for practice. From 1999 to 2006 its main output was the Drug and Alcohol Findings magazine but this has now been replaced by a free online database called the Effectiveness Bank.
